
Objective of the resource

Steps

What are the steps to complete the activity?


- 1. Access www.wordwall.net
- 2. Sign up. It's free!
- 3. Click on "Create activity"








4.Click on "Pick a template" and choose the random wheel

- Do you prefer face-to-face, blended or online classes? Why?
- What do you think about turning the webcam off during classes?

- Which Zoom feature would you like to have in face-to-face classes?
- What do you find most difficult about online classes?




6.Click on "Done", the blue botton in the corner
